

PROCESS OF EVENTS - ABOVE-GROUND POOL INSTALLATION

Contact is initiated for Pool Installation via phone or website form. We'll call and or email to schedule a home visit. We understand you have a lot of unique questions about your project. We want to meet you and answer all your questions.

From here if you decide to work with us. We will provide a written quotes based on your specific project. If accepted we will write up agreement to be signed by you. We collect 100\$ towards a pool installation and 50\$ for liner replacement. This is non refundable and it's to get onto our schedule. Once on the schedule the process is as follows.

The process of events:

1- The pool installation agreement gets signed, and your given an installation date.

2- As we get 1-3 weeks from installation day. We will call you to schedule the excavation visit. Most of our excavations take place 1-3 weeks prior to pool installation. Please don't be alarmed if we end up doing excavation within hours of install. Especially during busy season May-July.

Please Note: Sometimes weather is a factor. Should a weather event occur, we pick up where we left off. In the event we become backed up with a lot of installations due to inclement weather. We reserve the right to schedule around weather as necessary. We cannot predict the weather.

3- We will schedule delivery of Mason to the pool site. We hire an outside material supplier. In most cases this delivery comes while we are present. Sometimes these deliveries need to be made days prior or early morning before our scheduled time of installation.

In this case customer needs to be present to allow delivery. It's important you know where the base material goes if we aren't present. **Please see below pictures for the placement of the mason sand.**

In the event, we have no access for delivery to the pool site? Delivery will need to be made to your driveway. If we must move tonnage of this material from your driveway to the pool site by wheel barrel, it is 75\$ per 25ft, in extra charges.

4- Pool-Installation-Day. Please provide us with an electrical outlet in which we will need to plug in a vacuum. (We have extension cord's.) We will also need access to your water hose so we may start to fill your new pool. These are necessary to set the pool liner properly.

5- The filtration system gets connected to the pool via skimmer and return hoses. We only install Ladders and Steps Purchased from us. Please be advised we do not assemble ladder or steps purchased elsewhere.

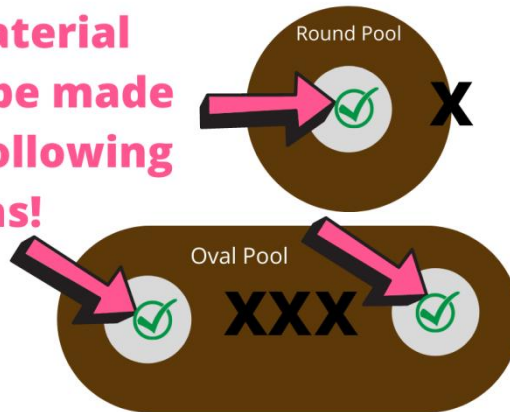
6- Once we have installed your new pool, you will continue filling it with the water hose. If you opted for a water truck to fill your swimming pool. Have the water truck come a day after installation. This is important for liner acclimation.

7- At this time we will hand over all warranty and brochure paperwork that was in the pool delivery boxes and Final payment is due at this time. Cash or check only please.
